Footnotes

ACCESSORIZE settled on the outside, ranged up while three to four wide on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, rallied to the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, inched clear into the final furlong and held under strong urging. GRAND ILLUMINATION settled off the pace, went three wide on the turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch, was put to a left-handed whip and closed determinedly to get the place. HIDATSA reared at the start, broke about five lengths behind the field, joined the back of the field inside the half-mile pole, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail, was asked near the quarter-pole, dove to the inside passing the three-sixteenths pole, rallied through a tight opening along the rail, closed well into the final furlong but flattened out and just missed the place. RESERVED INDIAN tracked the pace, chased two to three wide on the turn, made a mild bid near the quarter-pole and weakened. TRUE BLISS bumped lightly with a rival at the start, set the pace, controlled the tempo on the turn, lost the lead while under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. ENVOY'S RUNNING bumped lightly with a rival at the start, was taken up early, raced under tight restraint while rank, was finally given her head midway through the turn, saved ground into the stretch and faltered.
