Footnotes

TIZANEXPENSE was well rated while setting the pace, responded well when asked at the top of the stretch, dueled with MAJOR HOPE in the final furlong, had the rider lose his whip late and gamely prevailed. MAJOR HOPE raced three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased two to three wide on the far turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, made a bid passing the eighth-pole, dueled gamely with the winner in the final furlong and just missed. FLASHY SUNRISE raced towards the inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and closed well to secure the show. EMPIRE TAKER was well placed on the inside, came under urging on the far turn and lacked the needed response. TUCKERS POINT raced five then four wide on the first turn, settled near the back, moved up some with a half-mile to run, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and failed to rally. SEE ME PROUD raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and also failed to rally. ATTENDANT raced four then three wide on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, moved up some with a half-mile to run, saved ground on the far turn and failed to threaten. SEWANEE raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace and failed to respond. PAROLED was taken in hand early then reserved near the back, saved ground on the far turn and was no factor.
