Footnotes

ROCKIN GROOM set the pace on the inside, was challenged midway down the backstretch, vied inside on the far turn, dueled with BETIZZED in the stretch and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. BETIZZED jostled with BIG BOY PETE entering the first turn, was very hard held while just off the pace, moved up midway down the backstretch, drew even with the leader passing the half-mile pole, vied outside on the far turn, dueled with ROCKIN GROOM in the stretch and just missed. BANG BANG BERTI steadied off heels entering the first turn, went four then three wide on that bend, settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the far turn and was best of the rest. BIG BOY PETE jostled with BETIZZED entering the first turn, raced three then four wide on that bend, was rated just off the pace on the outside, chased three to four wide on the far turn and tired. MOREMAMBO raced three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, came up empty on the far turn and faded. WINNING VOWCHER was urged from the start, went three to four wide on the first turn, raced on the outside while ridden along on the backstretch and showed little. CHEROKEE MAN broke out at the start, raced four wide on the first turn, dropped back while under urging and faltered.
