GOSPEL LESSON went three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, made a bid leaving the backstretch, vied three wide on the far turn, battled with TYCOON in the stretch and narrowly prevailed under good handling. TYCOON set the pace on the inside, was challenged leaving the backstretch, dueled with GOSPEL LESSON in the stretch and just missed. MACHO BULL saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear, went four then five wide on the far turn, rallied on the outside and closed well but missed. BRAINWASH was caught six wide early on the first turn then dropped in, raced just off the pace, drafted behind the leaders on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, moved out some while under a drive in upper stretch, brushed with ADULARE outside the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. ADULARE went four to five wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn, brushed with BRAINWASH outside the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. SPEIGHTER MAN was hustled from the start, raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, came under urging outside the half-mile pole, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and tired. CHILLED raced four wide early on the first turn then dropped in, was through early and retreated then was eased but walked off.
