Footnotes

WHOOZIE vied along the rail, took over entering the final turn, increased her margin late. MESTIZA'S CRANE devoid of early foot, made a bold move five wide around the final turn and while no match for the winner bested the rest of the field. NALYNN close up along the rail, went after WHOOZIE nearing the turn and could not keep up late. PONCHO LADY saved ground until the drive, eased out and hung. FLUID MOVE three wide early, raced close up for six furlongs and faltered. STORMING UP lugged in at the break, hustled up four wide, gave way once reaching the drive. LA PLUMA broke through the gate prior to the start, contested the pace between rivals, then flattened out after five furlongs. KATIES' CHANCE three wide early, showed little. CANBERRA four wide early, dropped back quickly and was distanced.
