RIVER SOUNDS (IRE) saved ground while unhurried, eased out in upper stretch, moved back to the rail and proved best under strong handling. UNION MILLS forwardly placed, gained the edge around the second turn, dropped back a bit nearing mid stretch, came again but was out kicked. SPICY PROSPECTOR unhurried, circled six wide approaching the drive, surged clear and then failed to sustain his bid. EQUISTAR devoid speed, advanced between foes, angled out and was gaining late. FOUR FOR FOUR close up, eased out in the lane and had no late kick. RESPECT THE GAME was outrun. CORINTHIAN (IRE) back early, had no finish while wide. HOLD DOWN THE FORT tired. MON JULES trailed and showed little. PAVILLON clear early, was displaced before the drive and stopped. SPIT SHINE forward for six furlongs, gave way. PERFECT SLEEPER was always back.
