PANTUFFLA four wide early, advanced around the final turn, angled out and was up for second. LINDA COQUETA trailed until the drive and closed willingly. BAREFOOT DYANA raced wide and improved position. CRAFTY OAK four wide early, moved to contention around the final turn, offered her best and weakened late. QUIET FUN clear early, weakened readily once displaced. LOVELY PET bobbled just after the start, saved ground and dropped back. SUGAR CODED chased the leader for a half, gave way and was distanced.
