Footnotes

LAVA FIRE raced four then three wide on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, made a bid and was roused passing the five-sixteenths pole, battled with R S VALENTINE in the stretch and narrowly prevailed. R S VALENTINE went to the early lead, set the pace while off the rail, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled on the inside of LAVA FIRE and just missed. MISS RUFUS raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went four wide on the far turn, was roused with a right-handed whip in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, came under left hand-urging in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. POUR ME OUT was reluctant to load, settled on the inside, moved closer while urged along on the backstretch, chased inside on the far turn, was asked for more in upper stretch, came under a right-handed whip and lacked the needed kick. DOLLAR COTTON settled in the middle of the field while off the rail, was ridden along on the far turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong but also lacked the needed kick. MISS MARDI GRAS settled towards the rear of the field, was ridden along while two then three wide on the far turn, came under strong urging in upper stretch, was caught behind rivals near the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed response. SARAVA SOUND raced three then four wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went four then five wide early on the far turn, moved to six wide near the five-sixteenths pole and was no factor. AUNT MARLENE broke outward at the start, raced five wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, went three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide just inside the three-eighths pole and showed little.
