Footnotes

JIMANATOR raced three wide on the first turn, stalked the leader on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, edged clear under urging in upper stretch then drew off while ridden out. BURT'S A STITCH raced five then four wide early on the first turn, dropped to three wide late on that turn, settled just off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and weakened while just able to get the place. G. W.'S SILVER bumped with a rival at the start, lagged at the rear of the field while saving ground, moved off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch and just missed the place. ANTRIM COUNTY broke inward and bumped with a rival, raced three then two wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, was ridden along while three then four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. ASHE'S CAT came out at the start, was well rated while setting the pace, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and gave way. COMMODORE WAY raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, came up empty while four to five wide on the far turn and retreated. SQUANDER came out at the start, tracked the leader on the inside of JIMANATOR, came up empty near the five-sixteenths pole and stopped.
