MISS TAGGART broke very alertly from the outside post, quickly opened a clear lead, controlled the action while a bit off the rail on the turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch and held gamely under strong urging. MINNIE CHANCE was away alertly, tracked the leader on the outside, chased two to three wide on the turn, was asked for her best in upper stretch, closed determinedly on the outside and just missed. WIMBLETON STAR was urged along on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn and narrowly earned the show. BELLE MUSE settled off the pace, raced three wide while under some urging on the turn and failed to threaten. HUNT FOR COLLEEN was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and was no factor. VERY SPEIGHTSTOWN lacked early speed, dropped behind the field, raced inside on the turn, moved out approaching the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch and never reached contention. AVERY ROSE was urged along on the inside, saved ground on the turn and came up empty.
