Footnotes

TONIGHT WE DANCE settled towards the rear, went three then four wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide outside the quarter-pole, rallied outside into the final furlong and closed well to get up late. RATE CHANGE went four wide on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, came under some urging outside the half-mile pole, went two then three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide outside the quarter-pole, rallied into the final furlong and closed well but missed. ALLURING LADY went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced four then three wide on the far turn, took the lead at the top of the stretch, inched clear outside the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was caught while able to get the show. PHONYBOOKSNRECORDS broke a bit slow, went five then four wide on the first turn, settled at the rear, went four wide early on the far turn, dropped to one off the rail by the five-sixteenths pole, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, moved in during the final furlong and finished with good energy. I THINK SO went three wide on the first turn, was well placed behind the runaway leader, advanced leaving the backstretch, went three early on the far turn, took the lead outside the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to one off the rail, lost the advantage at the top of the stretch, chased into the final furlong and tired. CIDAQ bumped with MAGIC VIXEN entering the first turn then checked, was rated on the inside, advanced leaving the backstretch, came off the rail while chasing on the far turn, shifted three wide into the stretch and weakened. MAGIC VIXEN bumped with CIDAQ when given pressure from the outside by I THINK SO entering the first turn, ran-off while well clear on the lead, lost the advantage outside the five-sixteenths pole and stopped. JULIAMARIE raced three wide early on the first turn then dropped in, was through after a half-mile and retreated.
