MYLUTE went four then three wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, advanced leaving the backstretch, engaged the leader while three wide on the far turn, edged clear under a drive in upper stretch and drew off under the whip then was hand ridden in the final sixteenth. GENERAL ELECTION was unhurried while off the inside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, was roused while three wide on the far turn, came under the whip outside the quarter-pole and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. LATTIN DEVIL set the pace through tepid fractions, lost the lead at the quarter-pole, came under a drive, lost touch with the winner and proved no match for that rival then just missed the place. ARMY HERO went three then two wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, was ridden along while off the rail on the far turn and came up empty. HARDROCK ELEVEN fought the bit while inside on the first turn, settled more kindly on the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn, came off the rail at the quarter-pole and failed to respond. BOURBON PRIDE went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and also failed to respond.
