DUSTI'S TUNE reserved early, circled foes while advancing, rallied five wide, gained the edge and proved best while kept to a drive. PRIMA GREEN unhurried, circled foes seven wide while advancing and then did not have enough late. DYNAMISM never far back, rallied mildly. CATCH THE BOUQUET forward along the rail, had no kick. BLACKSTONE CLOCK back early, rallied wide and hung. MILLIGRAM tired. DYNAWAVE raced inside and had no rally. HOT TO TANGO devoid speed, was outrun. OUEST BANQUE forwardly placed, faded. TIMBER TURN was always outrun. HONDO CREEK showed early foot and then gave way. STORMIN ANNIE vied for the lead and then emptied out.
