PINPOINT vied between foes early, gained the edge around the turn, got clear before mid stretch, then was all out to hold on. SWEETENING out footed early, moved up three wide around the turn, loomed in the lane but could not overtake the top one. ERDISTON inside early, eased out around the turn, then came again for the show. STORMIN EDDIE devoid speed, moved to the inside approaching the turn, was eased out in the lane, but was no real threat. ADMIRAL HALSEY vied for the lead from the inside, got out footed around the turn, came again but flattened out. MAJESTIC COMMANDER prompted the pace three wide early, then gave way. WHO LET THE CAT IN was always outrun.
