ALACO CASTLE was hustled to the lead and set the pace, controlled the tempo while inside on the turn, responded well when asked in upper stretch and

drew off under right hand urging then was eased up in the final sixteenth. LIMEROCK was ridden along in the front half of the field, raced three to four wide on the turn and got up for the place while no match for the winner. SULTRY GENTLEMAN was well placed just off the pace, chased inside on the turn and weakened while able to get the show. PROSPECTIVE UNION broke through the gate prior to the start, chased the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and tired. CAESAR'S COIN broke through the gate prior to the start, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the turn and also tired. I TAKE DIAMONDS broke near the back of the field then lacked speed, raced four to five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and improved position without threatening. TCHEFUNCTE CHARLIE raced towards the rear of the field, went four then five wide on the turn and failed to respond. DORVAN dropped well back in the field, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. A. P. TIME was ridden along while well off the pace, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. HELLO BUD was urged along towards the outside, raced five to six wide on the turn and failed to respond. ISAIAH'S WALK raced well off the pace, went four to five wide on the turn and also failed to respond. FLYIN FAGER was hustled from the start, chased the winner through the turn and faded. CHATA IMA was reluctant to load, raced four to five wide on the turn and showed little. FINANCIALCHALLENGE was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and retreated.
