**Footnotes**

ROYAL SPOKESMAN broke a bit slow, moved up on the outside, raced four then three wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, was asked to pursue RADIO LOVER in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, rallied alongside that rival in upper stretch, gained a short lead into the final furlong then drew away under left hand urging. CHALECO raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, moved a bit closer while three wide on the far turn, dropped in a tad at the top of the stretch, came under right hand urging near the three-sixteenths pole, moved out and was switched to a left-handed whip near the furlong marker then gained the place while no match for the winner. RADIO LOVER was restrained while four wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, shook clear on the far turn, was set down in upper stretch, lost the lead passing the furlong marker and weakened then was caught for the place. DALE'S BLUE HEAVEN was taken in hand early then reserved towards the rear while near the inside, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths pole, lacked room behind TRULAKE when that rival dropped back on the far turn, found room and was roused at the top of the stretch, gained momentum into the final furlong and reached his best stride too late. TAPPED TO THE MAX settled off the pace, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, drifted out near the furlong marker and failed to rally. BIG BOB was taken in hand at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved towards the back, went three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. FAMOUS LITTLE KING hit the inside of the gate at the start, lagged at the rear of the field while saving ground and was no factor. TRULAKE was rank while hard held in the early going, continued under a snug hold on the backstretch, dropped back while off the rail on the far turn and came up empty. THE TEPIT broke near the back of the field then was hustled, took the lead into the first turn then was taken in hand, contested the pace on the backstretch, dropped out near the five-sixteenths pole and faded. (Rail at 20 Feet)
