TIGER ROCK moved to the early lead, set the clear pace, was asked at the top of the stretch, came under strong left hand urging near the three-sixteenths pole, extended the advantage into the final furlong and held sway under strong urging. TUPELO PLAYBOY settled off the pace while under some urging, raced off the rail on the turn, moved out inside the quarter-pole and was asked for more, gained his best stride into the final furlong and finished well to get the place. STORM HALF brushed with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, moved closer while three wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick while clear for the show. CY'S HOPE brushed with a rival at the start, raced well off the pace, went three wide on the turn, was roused at the top of the stretch, moved out near the three-sixteenths pole and improved position. ACTION FIGURE brushed with a rival at the start, chased the winner through the turn and tired. STRIKIN IKE brushed with a rival at the start and was off a bit slow, raced off the pace while reserved, went three wide on the turn, came under urging at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. DAHOMEY was urged along while off

the pace, raced four wide on the turn and came up empty. K J R GIT TYME chased the pace, raced inside on the turn and capitulated. STRIKING ARRIVAL was ridden along near the inside, dropped back with a half-mile to run, went two to three wide on the turn and failed to respond. BOBBYN BOUIE raced well back in the field, went three to four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. LEE GHOST lacked early speed, saved ground on the turn and was outrun. POLAR STORM was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide early on the turn then drifted to six wide, floated eight wide into the stretch and faltered.
