ALLWORKANDNOPLAY settled just off the pace, raced inside on the turn, made a rail bid in upper stretch, inched clear into the final furlong and held under repeated right hand urging. NORTH OF ALASKA was well placed just off the pace, raced two then three wide early on the turn, moved to four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong and finished willingly for the place. BARRACUDA BAY came in a bit at the start, contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled past the three-sixteenths pole and was outfinished while able to garner the show. FOREST COAST stumbled at the start then bumped with a rival, settled well off the pace, was urged some while two to three wide on the turn, moved out near the furlong marker and finished with good courage. NATIVE MAMBO broke inward at the start, contested the pace, vied off the rail on the turn, battled into the final furlong and weakened. HALTON GULLY bobbled at the start then bumped with FOREST COAST, raced well back in the field and failed to threaten. GENTLE MOMENT veered in at the start, was ridden along towards the rear, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. AFRICAN STORM tracked the pace, chased four to five wide on the turn and stopped. (Rail at 20 Feet)
