MUCH STRONGER broke out and brushed the outside of the gate, was rated while eager and off the rail on the first turn, moved up on the inside with five furlongs to run, contested the pace, vied inside on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, exchanged leads with THAAATS RIGHT, drifted out in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed. BETHEL resisted the initial rating tactics of the rider, raced inside on the first turn, settled off the rail on the backstretch, was ridden along while inside on the far turn, moved out at the top of the stretch, came under the whip, gained in the final furlong, moved out late and just missed. THAAATS RIGHT went to the front, set the pace on an easy lead, was challenged near the five-eighths pole, picked up the tempo alongside MUCH STRONGER on the far turn, exchanged leads while battling with the aforementioned rival, drifted out near the sixteenth-pole and missed. MONEY CANNON went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, came under urging leaving the backstretch, dropped further behind the two leaders while three wide on the far turn, gained ground in the final furlong but also missed in a four-way photo. BARRY SHORTPANTS was a bit eager early, went three to four wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, came under urging leaving the backstretch, went three to four wide on the far turn and failed to respond.
