WILDCAT SHOES vied for the lead, shook clear before the drive and steadily increased his margin while kept to a drive. TWO DOWN AUTOMATIC out sprinted early, moved to the rail around the turn and then closed gamely to gain the place late. BRITT'S JULES vied for the lead until before the drive and then weakened late. NEXT BANDIT settled three wide and had no response. STALKERAZZI brushed the gate at the break, was parked wide while outrun down the backstretch, eased in a bit around the turn and then was no real threat. XTRA JACK devoid speed, was not a factor. SUNRISE LAUNCH showed little. DEPOP saved ground while outrun.
