Footnotes

ALERT WARRIOR stalked the leader on the outside, was asked at the top of the stretch, took over near the three-sixteenths pole and drew clear under strong urging. TO DUBAI broke a bit slow, was urged along early, moved up between rivals near the half-mile pole, raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and earned the place while unable to threaten the winner. HUNTERWOOD POINT settled just off the pace while off the inside, was urged along on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. MY SAMURAI dropped back after the start, settled at the rear, raced off the rail on the turn and improved position. BEER MAN showed good speed, set the pace near the inside, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. THE HIDDEN ACE tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the turn and tired. FIFTY FIVE SOUTH was well placed just off the pace, dropped back while inside on the turn and came up empty. BOREGO'S BARBARIAN was urged along on the outside, raced four to five wide on the turn and faded.
