### Footnotes

PALMER TOUR settled on the outside while under some urging, went three then four wide on the turn, rallied to the lead in upper stretch and drew away under steady urging. RACING CAJUN pressed the pace on the outside, drew even passing the half-mile pole, edged clear while three wide on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and proved no match for the winner while able to get the place. DEWBERRY chased the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn, pursued the winner into the final furlong and tired while just able to get the show. KING CHARGER was ridden along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. PIRATE MYSTERY broke two lengths behind, raced at the rear while ridden along, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, swung six wide into the stretch, moved further to the outside and failed to threaten. CHANCE IDE TAKE was ridden along while off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced two then three wide on the turn, shifted four wide into the stretch and came up empty. OFF THE MAP was ridden along in the middle of the field, saved ground on the turn, shifted three wide outside the quarter-pole and failed to respond. FORTY MORE WINS chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and capitulated. ROANA'S ROAR set the pace under pressure, lost the lead on the turn, dropped out near the five-sixteenths pole and stopped.
