BOLD RECRUIT pressed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, gained the lead in upper stretch and drew clear under strong urging. ROYAL PRODUCTION contested the pace on the inside of rivals, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced off the rail on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. HIT THE ROAD LEE was urged along while off the pace, moved in near the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn, moved out near the furlong marker and finished willingly to just miss the place. SOUTHERN DUDE settled just off the pace, was urged along while four wide on the turn and lacked the needed kick. PATRYKUS dropped back at the start, raced near the back of the field while off the rail, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to menace. GO FUZZY settled off the pace, went six then five wide on the turn and failed to rally. CANON MAN settled in the middle of the field, raced five wide on the turn and also failed to rally. GEORGIA GLITTER was hustled from the start, contested the pace while well off the inside, vied off the rail on the turn and gave way. FOREIGN PRODUCTION was urged along towards the rear, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced inside on the turn and showed little. (Rail at 20 Feet)
