Footnotes

NINTH WARD MAN was hustled from the start, set the pace while off the rail, dropped a bit closer to the inside on the far turn, battled gamely in the stretch and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. TWO TO LOAD went four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid while two to three wide on the far turn, battled between rivals in the stretch and just missed. BOOK OF RULES went four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, came under urging while three then four wide on the far turn, made a bid in upper stretch, battled outside of the top two and missed in a three-way photo. DUELING OAKS went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the inside of TWO TO LOAD, chased while off the rail on the far turn, steadied behind the leading duo at the top of the stretch, moved to the outside and lacked the needed kick. HE'SAMIGHTYMINT broke about three to four lengths slow, angled in at the back of the field, raced inside into the first turn then shifted four wide, lagged at the rear, was ridden along on the far turn, swung seven wide into the stretch and improved position. SIR SOXS bumped with a rival at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was

urged along while four to five wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. DANZIG'S FAULT went four then three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, raced three wide on the far turn, split horses passing the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. WANNA BE FAMOUS settled in the middle of the field, moved up midway down the backstretch, was urged along on the far turn, floated four wide into the stretch and came up empty. THE LAST DAY bumped with an opponent at the start, was in a bit tight entering the first turn, raced three then two wide on that turn, settled off the pace, moved up midway down the backstretch, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and failed to respond. MARSH MASTER bumped with a rival at the start, went four to five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and had nothing left. LUNAR IMPULSE broke a bit slow, was reserved towards the rear, remained under restraint on the far turn and never reached contention. ROYAL CELEBRATION was well placed on the inside, came up empty on the far turn and stopped.
