**Footnotes**

WE FOUND LOVE was ridden along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, rallied to the lead in upper stretch, drew clear into the final furlong and held under steady urging. SKINNY was ridden along while off the pace, raced towards the inside on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. DIXIE FORTY FIVE was urged along towards the rear, raced three then four wide on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch and got up for the show. SHELBY SCOTT was hard ridden in the second flight while on the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, came off the rail on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to rally. PURE CAJUN brushed with a rival at the start, dueled on the outside, vied into upper stretch then tired. HICKISSIPPI brushed with a rival at the start, dueled on the inside, vied into upper stretch then gave way. VOW TO FUND GOLD was void of speed, raced five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. ITSY BITSY WALK was ridden along in the back half of the field, raced off the rail on the turn and was no factor. HARD WORKING DAN was ridden along between horses in the second flight, dropped back leaving the backstretch, went four wide on the turn and came up empty. KENZIE'S HEAT was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and failed to respond. DERBLIN broke awkwardly then was taken up, raced towards the rear, went three wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and also failed to respond. MALIBU CLASSIC was ridden along in the back half, raced inside on the turn and showed little.
