ADRIANNE G was away very alertly, had HOOKAH LADY clip her heels early, set the pace, controlled the action while off the rail on the turn, was set down at the three-sixteenths pole, drifted out outside the sixteenth-pole and held under strong urging. EXPRESS MODEL pressed the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the turn, pursued the leader under whip into the final furlong, raced just inside of KISS TO REMEMBER in the process, dropped inside the winner when that rival drifted out coming to the sixteenth-pole, battled determinedly to the wire and missed. KISS TO REMEMBER moved out near the half-mile pole, chased four wide on the turn, pursued the winner under the whip on the outside and finished willingly but settled for the show. JENNY VIGNETTE raced off the pace while on the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, came off the rail before the five-sixteenths, shifted three wide into the stretch, was put to the whip and failed to rally. WAR PORT steadied to avoid the fallen rider early, moved up late on the backstretch, raced off the rail into the turn then dropped to the inside, saved ground under urging into the stretch and tired. HOOKAH LADY clipped heels early and unseated the rider. Following a stewards' inquiry into the incident on the backstretch and also the stretch run, there was no change made.
