TANITA BELLE was hustled to the lead, set the pace, dictated terms while inside on the turn, was set down in upper stretch, dueled gamely with the runner-up in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. THIEVES GUILD bumped hard with rivals on both sides at the start, was coaxed along in the front half of the field, went two then three wide on the turn, gained under a drive in upper stretch, made a bid passing the eighth-pole, dueled gamely with the winner in the final furlong and just missed. KATIE'S EYES showed good speed then chased on the outside, raced three then two wide on the turn, came under a down-turned right-handed whip after turning into the stretch, had the rider fumble the whip while uncocking it near the three-sixteenths pole, caught the whip in mid-air shortly thereafter, switched to a left-handed stick near the eighth-pole, pursued the top two under a drive and finished with good courage to get the show. SILK PURSE bumped with a rival at the start, was in tight against the rail early, moved up then chased the pace, tried to lug out a bit while inside on the turn, saved ground into the stretch and tired. SWEET BASIL bumped hard with an opponent at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn, shifted three wide outside the quarter-pole and failed to rally. MATHAAYIL settled well back in the field, raced three wide into the turn then dropped in, came into the stretch behind a rival, was asked shortly thereafter and failed to threaten. FALSE CLOCK

settled on the outside, went four wide into the turn, dropped to one off the rail shortly thereafter, angled out in upper stretch and never reached contention. SUGAR PIE bumped hard with a rival at the start, settled off the pace while under some urging, raced off the rail on the turn, shifted four wide outside the quarter-pole and failed to respond. TIZ LATELY raced well back in the field, went three wide early on the turn, dropped to the inside near the three-eighths pole, saved ground from that point into the stretch and was no factor. MISS DREAM CAT bumped with an opponent at the start, was void of speed, raced off the rail on the turn and showed little. FIRST FREEDOM was urged along on the outside, went four wide on the turn and capitulated. ARLINGTON GETAWAY showed speed then chased the pace, dropped back between rivals near the five-sixteenths and faded.
