Footnotes

SOLDIER'S DREAM devoid speed, raced wide down the backstretch, came four wide around the second turn, ranged up outside MIRIAM L. nearing the drive, gained the edge a furlong out and prevailed. MIRIAM L. angled in going to the first turn, settled until nearing the second turn, eased outside CASH ECONOMY to advance, bid three wide, surged clear and then just missed. A PISA WORK eased to the rail early, moved out approaching the second turn, split foes and then lacked the needed finish. PARIS PRIDE between foes early, angled out before reaching the backstretch, raced wide down the backstretch, split foes around the second turn and then hung. NO LITTLE CASE bobbled after the break, was restrained while outrun, split foes around the second turn and then could make little impact. CASH ECONOMY close up early, eased out a bit approaching the second turn, moved back in for the drive and then had no rally. HOUR STORM off last, was outrun. ROMANTIC LOVE dueled for the lead until the second turn and then faltered. LOVE ON TAP showed early foot and then dropped back. POP'S CARLEE was always back. MOONLIGHT BUNNY wide early, faded. CAROLEENA forced the pace for a half and then stopped.
