QUIET COMMAND settled while off the inside, moved closer outside the half-mile pole, waited leaving the far turn, moved out behind rivals in upper stretch, rallied on the outside, made a bid entering the final furlong and drew clear under good handling. BAD RONNIE was unhurried at the back while saving ground, moved closer on the far turn, waited briefly at the quarter-pole, moved out while under a drive in upper stretch and finished willingly to get the place. RIDINGFORTHEBRAND prompted the pace while off the inside, took the lead in upper stretch, led into the final furlong then weakened while able to hold the show. FOREST COLORS settled towards the rear, raced three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. SING SONG CAT moved to the lead while inside on the first turn, set the pace through moderate fractions, vied inside on the far turn, lost the advantage in upper stretch and gave way. VPERYOD SERYOGA raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, was ridden along while four wide on the far turn and tired. VAN MAR went four to five wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and capitulated. WEAGLE was eager while in hand into the first turn then reserved on the rail, moved up outside the half-mile pole, saved ground on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and came up empty. GIANT MINGUN went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, raced two to three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. (Rail at 20 Feet)
