Footnotes

MY FRIEND TAG chased the pace on the outside, raced five wide on the turn, floated seven wide into the stretch, gained the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, inched clear into the final furlong and proved best under strong urging. LOST HIGHWAY broke out and bumped hard with LONE STAR TOUR, raced just off the pace, was urged along while two to three wide on the turn, chased in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. ROBIN'S SPORT was away well, set the pace, controlled the action while three wide on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and weakened while just able to get the show. LONE STAR TOUR was bumped hard on both sides at the start then bobbled and was taken up, raced well off the pace while urged along, went two to three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. SHINE HE WILL was ridden along on the far outside, raced six wide on the turn, ducked inward in upper stretch and tired. CUTE TO BOOT was well placed just off the pace, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. CRONUS broke very awkwardly then ducked out, spotted the field several lengths, raced towards the rear, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. WAR CHANCELOR hit the inside of the gate then bumped hard with LONE STAR TOUR, was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to respond. NIGHTLY MONOLOGUE broke a bit awkwardly then was taken up, raced well off the pace, went six wide on the turn and never reached contention. MISTER

CHESTNUT broke about three to four lengths slow, raced at the rear and also never reached contention. COOLCIDEUP dropped back while ridden along, raced inside on the turn and retreated.
