Footnotes

FLASHPOINT bumped lightly with FIRE ALARM at the start, was well placed just off the pace while on the inside, drafted behind the pacesetter on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, rallied along the rail into the final furlong, made a bid near the sixteenth-pole and gamely prevailed in a blanket finish. PASS THE DICE was bumped on both sides at the start, settled off the pace, ranged up while three to four wide on the turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, battled gamely while outside in the stretch and just missed. NEXT RIGHT THING came away in good order, quickly sped clear, controlled the tempo while a bit off the rail on the turn, was asked outside the three-sixteenths pole, battled gamely in the final furlong and just missed. AMANECER DE ORO tracked the pace on the outside, went two to three wide on the turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, battled gamely between rivals in the stretch and also just missed. WASH PARK settled on the outside, remained unasked while two three wide on the turn, angled out while put to a drive inside the quarter-pole, rallied on the outside and closed strongly but was too late. FIRE ALARM bumped lightly with FLASHPOINT at the start then bumped soundly with PASS THE DICE, was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick. SHRILL bumped with PASS THE DICE at the start, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. GOODTIMEHADBYALL was urged along while well behind, raced off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten.
