KISSER N RUN raced in the back for the first mile and a half, quickly got into contention on the back stretch going to the ninth jump, maintained pressure through the final turn, jumped the last with two other rivals and had enough left for the win. OPERA HEROINE was never far off the pace, stalked the leader on the backside for the final time, was right there jumping the last dueled with the winner but could not keep up for the win. THE GREY EXPRESS (GB) inherited the lead between calls when MISSTERIA lost her rider, maintained command until the final jump then weakened late. TAKE HER TOTHE TOP was in no hurry early, made steady progress jumping the three jumps on the backside for the final time, was in the mix jumping the last then flattened out. CASABLANCA LILY (IRE) was up close for the first mile and a half, lost some ground then was even from there. CLASS LAUNCH trailed the field, picked up tired rivals in the stretch. CUBIST was in the back of the pack and was no factor here. BITTERSWEETHEART (GB) was never a threat. RAY DE LIGHT got into contention on the backstretch for the final time, then stopped. MISSTERIA was in contention when she lost her rider after stumbling jumping the eighth jump. MAYA CHARLI took command from the beginning opened up a wide margin then stopped entering the backstretch for the final time. WELL FASHIONED refused to start.
