Footnotes

IMPERIAL GIN rated in the middle of the pack while racing three-wide, responded when asked going into the far turn, gained a short lead before the last jump while widest, quickly drew off when roused once and won with speed to spare. DOUBLE DOORS (GB) stalked the early pace, dueled on the outside into the second backstretch, eased back a bit, dueled again on the outside at the eighth jump, drew clear into the far turn, responded strongly to winner's bid but proved no match. BROTHER SY rated on the outside through the first circuit, moved up to duel for the lead between rivals before the sixth jump, pressed the pace on the second backstretch, contested the lead into the far turn and weakened nearing the last jump. MEMORIAL MANIAC saved ground near the back of the pack, had no rally and passed tiring rivals. ICE BEAR raced wide in the middle of the pack and had no rally. ALFARABI trailed into the last yards and passed one tired rival. SERGEANT KARAKORUM quickly took command, dueled on the inside late in the first circuit, regained his lead approaching the backstretch the second time, dueled again into the far turn and gave way. ROYAL FLING SHOT broke well to be well placed early, lost his coordination landing the third jump, ducked left and was pulled up.
