CLASS SKIP was allowed to settle behind the pace but was never far back, saving ground on the inside jumping the second last, took command shortly after that, jumped the last a length in front and was ridden out to the wire. PEACE FIRE was close up through out rallied after the second last in the far turn but could not catch the winner. DR. WHEAT tried to back out at the start then ducking to the inside crashing into DEMONSTRATIVE, unseating his rider, got going and caught the field with a mile to go, made steady progress down the back side for the final time, rallied in the far turn, jumped the last four wide and dueled with PEACE FIRE and just missed second. UNION ARMY always in contention but had no rally from the last fence home. WORRIED MAN well placed, evenly. DANCE FASTER stalked pace, stopped after second last jump. DAKOTA SLEW through after a mile. ST OF CIRCUMSTANCE took command from the start, was in front until the second last jump, then tired badly and pulled up before the last jump. GREAT HALO fell back after a mile and a half, trailed and was pulled up before the last fence. DEMONSTRATIVE was plowed into by DR. WHEAT at the start unseating his rider. The Stewards disqualified DR. WHEAT from third and was declared unplaced for interference at the start.
