CHROME COINS was well placed along the three path, angled out, asked and closed well. ATHENA BAY broke well, set the pace along the rail, was hooked and weakened. DESK REFERENCE two path on the turn, lodged a bid and hung. WILL YOU DANCE ducked in at the start bothering the winner, tracked along the two path and tired. MIRTHFUL FLIRT bobbled at the start and then saved ground. BEAUTY BY GEORGE five wide on the turn and then finished wide. FINAL TAKE three path on the turn, was outrun. SHAHZADI six wide on the turn and then finished wide. ONE WHITE SOCK four path on the turn and tired.
