PIANO STAR was well placed, blocked at the top of the lane and weakened. SIR GUSTA vied for the lead along the rail and weakened. GRANBY BOY five wide on the turn and weakened. BISTRO SOIREE saved ground to no avail. HIGHLY DISCREET four path on the turn and tired. JUNALUSKA five wide on the turn and tired.
