SNEAKIN THE GOLD broke on top, set the pace along the three path and then widened. TRACK MAGNET saved ground well placed and finished well. TEN BELLS well placed along the three path and finished with interest. SURFING IAN tracked along the two path and weakened. VINNIES WILD TALE four path on the turn and then failed to threaten. GUNSIGHT MOUNTAIN three path on the turn and tired. POLICY WONK four path on the turn and tired. TOO TOUGH JAKE hesitated badly at the start spotting the field eight lengths while losing all chance. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning the start, resulted in no change.
