ICE CARNIVAL broke sharply, drifted in some nearing the seven-sixteenth pole bothering STREET WHEELING slightly while going for the lead, quickly opened up and then widened late to win handily. STREET WHEELING checked nearing the seven-sixteenth pole when the winner drifted in some, tracked that one throughout to no avail but finished clearly best of the rest. CHAIN LETTER removed from the pace and the rail, eased out some in the lane, lodged a bid but was clearly no match for the top two finishers. SWEET REBECCA N was unhurried along the four path on the turn and then lacked a solid bid. LIVEITUPNOW chased the winner while three abreast on the turn and then weakened. CLIFDEN STAR removed from the rail, was outrun. DR F LAPARCO saved ground while close up early and then tired. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of STREET WHEELING against the winner for interference at the seven-sixteenth pole, was not allowed.
