Footnotes

SHAKER LAKES was well positioned along the rail, eased out to the three path into the lane, challenged three across and edged clear. SHAHZADI vied for the lead along the two path, battled between in the lane but was no match. SHUTTLE CRAFT set the pace along the rail, was hooked at the top of the lane, battled inside and weakened. DONIA never far back, three path into the lane and weakened. TALL TIMBERCOWGIRL lagged back saving ground, was not a factor. MIRTHFUL FLIRT five wide well placed early, four path on the turn and finished wide. SMALL POTATOES three path on the turn and tired.
