TRACK MAGNET four path on the turn and then made a late bid. T. G. HERO vied for the lead along the rail to midstretch and weakened. SMOOTH KAHLUA two path on the turn and failed to respond. PRINCE CODY ducked out at the start and then was five wide on the turn.
