SCARY TRIP was well placed, angled out in the lane, took dead aim and under the whip proved best. IVAN'S SONG broke well, set the pace off the rail, was hooked late, battled to on avail but held the place. WESNIAK was well placed along the four path, angled wide in the lane and finished well. DAVID IS MAD was unhurried, angled wide in the lane and then lacked a rally. THRESHER jostled at the start, lagged back, three path on the turn and then failed to fire. DAY OF SUFFERING tracked along the rail and weakened. EVEN PAR was unhurried off the rail and then fell entering the lane. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning EVEN PAR, resulted in no change.
