SUSPICIOUS U was hustled to the front, set the pace along the rail, responded when challenged in midstretch and under the whip turned back CREA'S LAW for the win. CREA'S LAW was unhurried along the two path, gained some on that path on the final turn, responded in the late stages and finished with good energy. DIAMOND SHOWCASE gained along the rail up the backstretch, tracked around the last bend along the two path, collared the winner a furlong out and then weakened late. VIRGING ON STARDOM was unhurried along the rail, angled out four wide into the last turn, gained three from the rail into the lane, angled to the outside and flattened out. AMERICAN BUFFALO never far back up the backstretch, in striking distance along the fence on the last bend and then had nothing left for the stretch. COCOBOLO was well placed up the backstretch and then was done on the final bend. MIDNIGHT TUCKER three path into the backstretch and then was done on the final turn.
