SWEET HOURS broke on top, set the pace along the three path, was hooked nearing the quarter pole, battled, responded and under the whip proved best. ROYAL EXPRESSION was unhurried along the four path on the turn, angled out for the drive, responded when asked and rallied. KEEN NANA was well placed, gained ground along the four path on the turn, collared the winner, battled and then weakened. EARNED RUN saved ground while close up, lodged a bid and weakened. K D FORUM five wide on the turn, gained some and then weakened. IM NO LADY lagged back, angled out in the lane and then lacked a solid bid. MOMENTA six wide on the turn, was not a factor. ONE TO LOVE three path on the turn, tired. EVENING TRICK five wide leaving the backstretch, three path on the turn and tired.
