NEW YORK STYLE broke on top, set the pace while pressed, shook clear on the final turn and then was all out to last. SHOW THE FLAG was well placed, tracked along the three path on the last turn, gained and just missed. BORACAY WONDER never far back, lodged a bid inside but was no match for the top two. CHARMING COUNTRY was well placed along the three path on the last turn and weakened. BEDROCK BLUES gained along the four path on the last turn and then flattened out. DONE THAT forced the issue up the backstretch while saving ground and tired.
