SWEET SWEET MOLLY saved ground early, angled out to the four path midway on the turn, gained into the lane, reached contention in midstretch, responded to pressure and proved best nearing the line. SEMICHI tracked the pacesetter off the rail, chased into the lane, took command in midstretch, battled with the winner late and finished gamely. DAVID'S DILEMMA tracked the leader early, four path into the lane, gained, loomed a threat and then weakened late. REAL ASSETS broke sluggishly, lagged back along the three path, angled out in the lane and made a late bid. PERSONAL HALF MAST was unhurried off the rail on the bend, eased out in the lane and then lacked a closing bid. TOUCHY BROAD five wide on the turn, angled out for the drive and weakened. SHEILAS DESIRE broke well, set the pace along the three path, was hooked in upper stretch, battled briefly and tired. FOREVER FLAWLESS lagged back, was outrun. POW WOW LOUISE between foes close up early and tired. TIME FOR KARAKORUM three path on the turn, tired.
