PASSING TIME away on top, vied for the lead along the rail, cleared in the lane and under the whip held sway. CHECK THE CITES was well placed four wide into the turn, three path into the lane and finished well. WISEMAN JACK broke sluggishly, gained along the three path on the turn and then closed well late. FIRST VERSE vied for the lead along the two path, chased and weakened. MR. VENTURA T broke slow, lagged back along the rail, angled out and made a late bid. EARLY RESPONSE was unhurried along the rail and tired. HURRICANE HEAT two path on the turn and tired.
