DANCIN DAZE was unhurried along the four path on the turn, was set down for the drive in midstretch and rallied under the whip to nail CHICK POWER at the line. CHICK POWER set the pace along the rail while pressed, shook loose into the lane and then couldn't last. BELLA TA TI TA forced the issue along the three path, chased on the turn, lodged a bid in the lane and then weakened. REALLY SOMETHING was allowed to settle along the three path on the turn and then failed to fire. HOMESLICE was close up along the rail early and then tired. IFEELMISTY eight wide trip, showed little. ANGELA D five wide on the turn while close up and then faded.
