EXACT AGAIN contested the lead form between foes, kicked clear when asked and proved best. LISCANNOR BAY vied for the lead along the rail, chased in the lane, altered out leaving the furlong marker and finished with good energy. LINEAR MOTION was well placed, gained four wide on the turn and finished well. DISTINCTIVE LOVER vied for the lead three across, chased in the lane and weakened. MONO CLIFFS was well placed along the three path while between foes and weakened. STAR OF ROME two path on the turn and finished wide. IMPRESS THE CHIEF was well placed early, two path rounding the bend and faded. FLAGLER BEACH was unhurried, three path into the lane and tired. KING'S FEZ ducked in at the start, saved ground, checked at the top of the lane and then finished wide.
