LIFE RUNNER broke sharply, showed the way along the three path and under the whip held sway for the score. MARK'S ON ATTACK bumped at the start by FIDDLE FOR A BUCK, was unhurried along the four path on the turn, angled out in the lane and then closed well to narrowly earn the place. FIDDLE FOR A BUCK bumped with MARK'S ON ATTACK at the start, stalked four abreast early, three abreast five wide on the turn, chased in the lane to no avail and then just missed the place. DADOWAY stalked the winner from between three deep, between on the bend and then weakened. DIAMOND DISTRICT tracked along the rail and weakened. STORM'S A COMIN was unhurried five wide on the turn, continued wide in the straight and then lacked a rally. DADDY'S B. E. T. saved ground, lacked room and then checked at the three-eighths pole. ARDDGUN off the rail early and then angled out to four path midway on the bend. MAHEMSHA tracked the winner from between early and tired.
