DADDY'S WILDCAT broke on top, toyed with LOCAL LEGACY early, took charge into the lane and then widened to win easily. LOCAL LEGACY forced the issue early, tracked into the lane, chased to no avail but finished well. GANADOR was well placed along the two path, angled out in the lane and hung. POINT CUMANA never far back along the three path and finished with interest. SRIRACHA two path on the turn and then failed to response. ROCKING OUT lagged back along the two path leaving the backstretch, three path into the lane and then failed to take part. HAROLDS WARRIOR was well placed along the rail and tired. UNGUIDED MISSILE saved ground and tired. KILLER DILLER lagged back along the three path, was outrun.
